## **BOPF Open Forum at Triodos Foundation venue**

Triodos Foundation venue, Lower Ground Floor, St George's Road, Bristol, BS1 5BE  
five minutes' walk from the City Hall/Cathedral/Park Street

**The Foundation entrance is not the main Triodos bank entrance:** walk past the Triodos Bank entrance on your right on Deanery Road, then turn right into St George Road.  
**Alternatively**, if you want to **avoid the incline pavement on the corner**, the venue can also be accessed from St George's Road - walk past the College Green bus stop up Park Street until St George's Road is reached on the first turning left. Carry on along the road until the Triodos Foundation is reached at the end.
